THE CHALLENGE

Our client, Burton, wanted to find a solution that could replace the current middleware layer (Mulesoft technology) and, simultaneously, be able to trace all integrations according to the business flow, change the integration content and reprocess flows.

GOALS

With this project, our client was seeking to:

- Discontinue the existing software instance;
- Integrate the various applications with the systems of partner suppliers;
- Provide a log of all events that occur during the various existing processes and integrations.

SOLUTION

The developed solution was a pipeline application that gives the user a powerful monitoring tool where it is possible to have an overview of all the processes and integrations that are running, finished and those that gave an error. For each one of them, an event pipeline is created and can be later analyzed if necessary.

With this tool the user is able to easily identify where the errors occur and consequently fix them. The Pipeline application monitors processes that integrate systems with different protocols and technologies, including RFCs for SAP access, file transfer via SMB, SFTP and SCP, REST and SOAP Services.

RESULTS

After this project, Burton achieved several positive results, from which we highlight:

- **Better Integration** monitoring by IT users and business users;
- **Better UX/UI** with a modern and user-friendly interface;
- **Flexible Configuration** of the various systems integration;
- **Real-Time Indicators** on customized dashboards to facilitate analysis.
